

## **Scheme for «Saving Energy – Upgrading of Enterprises»**

### **Summary**

The Scheme aims to upgrade energy renovation of SME's buildings, including usage of Renewable Energy Systems that are used by natural or legal person governed by private law who are owners or tenants of SMEs building and are exercising economic activity.

This purpose would be achieved by providing non- repayable financial aid during this first Call for Proposals. The type of incentive may be revised to the remaining Calls.

### **Summary of Call Description**

Beneficiaries are all natural or legal persons engaged in economic activity, governed by private law, who are owners or tenants of Small and Medium Enterprises (SMEs) buildings.

The Scheme includes the following two ( 2 ) types of investments:

A. Integrated Energy Renovation of Buildings for achieving at least B class of energy efficiency in the Energy Performance Certificate (EPC) or energy saving at least 40 % relative to the total building energy consumption before upgrading.

B. Integrated Energy Renovation of Buildings for upgrading to nearly zero energy consumption, as defined in the relevant Decree issued by the Minister for Energy, Trade, Industry and Tourism under the arrangements of the Energy Performance of Buildings Laws of 2006-2012.

Grants that will be granted to beneficiaries who will join the Scheme are:

- 50 % of the total approved budget of the proposal for the first type of investment and
- 75 % of the total approved budget of the proposal for the second type of investment.

Eligible costs cover a wide range of energy saving measures in buildings , among which are insulate of buildings shell, replacement of heating / air conditioning systems, installation of renewable energy systems for heating / cooling , installation of electricity saving systems etc. The maximum grant amount per beneficiary amounts to €200.000. The type of aid provided, is the deminimis aid.

Priority for approval will be determined based on the order of submission of fully completed proposals.

### **Proposal Submission**

Call is open until 23 December 2016 or until the total budget of the call is available.
